MEETING MINUTES

November 19, 2013 Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Heinz Ickert. Others in attendance were Danny Case, Aaron Eckstein, Sam Smith, Mike Day, Chrissie Powers, and Melissa Smart.

The following agenda items were discussed at the meeting:



Despite having the perfect environment to play duck duck goose, no games were played.

The following agenda items summarize the board meeting:

- ♦ The September 2013 minutes of the Board meeting was approved. Danny Case reported that there were currently 79 paid members for 2013 and 12 paid members for 2014.
- ♦ The treasurer report was given by Aaron Eckstein and approved by the Board. The chapter has a cash balance of \$36,493.08 through October 2013. There was discussion concerning the amount of luncheon fees. It was decided to review them based upon next year's contract. Another item of expense which was discussed was the rental from the Boat Club for the use of a projector and screen. Danny indicated that he could bring a projector from AEP at no cost which would save on the rental expense.
- Heinz informed the Board that he had been notified that the ACFE chapters could no longer use Nationals NASBA number for qualifying CPE. The National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) wants each chapter to register and obtain their own number. Heinz stated that he would have Henry Smith-Training Director research this issue more thoroughly.
- Melissa stated she was working on the social outing at the LEPD Firearms and Range (999 Bethel Road) for the evening of December 12, 2013. Potential cost was \$10-\$12 per member. Members needed to arrive on time in order to receive a safety briefing and sign the required waivers. The Board also agreed it would be a good idea to have the participants sign waivers related to the chapter's responsibility.
- Heinz distributed to the Board members a booklet from StarChapter which provided information concerning their management of websites. Board members were requested to review the information for discussions at a future meeting.
- ♦ It was stated that the chapter's tax return has been filed.
- ♦ In an update on the Emerging Trends conference, it was stated that there were still a few speaker slots to fill. The speaker budget has been compiled for review.
- ♦ The Board discussed the fraud training being held on January 14, 2014 with the Central Ohio Chapter of the Institute of Internal Auditors. It was decided even though the training was for a full-day, the regularly scheduled monthly luncheon on January 21, 2014 would still be held.
- ♦ A motion was made and approved to adjourn the meeting.
