

SEPTEMBER 20, 2011 MINUTES OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Heinz Ickert. Others in attendance were Danny Case, Chrissie Powers, Peter Kimani, Sam Smith, Melissa Smart, and Henry Smith.

The following agenda items were discussed at the meeting:

The minutes of the August 23, 2011 Board meeting were approved.

- Currently, the Central Ohio chapter has 107 members.
- ➤ The Treasurer's report presented by Peter Kimani was reviewed and accepted by the Board. The chapter currently has a balance of \$27,706.99 in all accounts.
- ➤ Peter indicated that the supply of speaker gifts is running low and will need to be replenished. Heinz indicated that he will review the items available from ACFE.
- ➤ Henry Smith presented the Training Director's Report stating that one of the three individuals in the 2011 class will not be completing the program. He has not received a recent status report but will request them from the individuals. Members wishing to be in the 2012 class should contact Henry.
- ➤ The Board had a discussion concerning the amount of the current luncheon fees and membership fees. The current fee level has been in place for many years while certain costs have increased. They Board approved the following changes which are effective immediately:

Luncheon Fees

Current– Members \$12.00 Non-Members \$14.00 New Fees – Members \$16.00 Non-Members \$20.00

Membership Fees

All classifications increased by \$5.00

- Melissa had forwarded to the Board members an email from an individual at the Auditor of State office who wanted to discuss the 2012 Emerging Trends Conference. Melissa and Heinz indicated that they will meet with this individual and report back to the Board.
- ➤ The Board also discussed forming a committee to look at the Chapter's future options related to the Emerging Trends conference and other avenues of providing CPE to members. Danny,

- Melissa, Chrissie, and Sam indicated that they would be interested in this committee.
- ➤ The Board discussed the position of Student Liaison. Heinz will make an announcement at the luncheon that the Board is looking for someone to fill this position.
- ➤ A motion was made and approved to adjourn the meeting.
