MEETING MINUTES

September 17, 2013:

The meeting was called to order by Heinz Ickert. Others in attendance were Danny Case, Aaron Eckstein, Sam Smith, and Kevin Brun.

The following agenda items summarize the board meeting:

♦ The June and August 2013 minutes of the Board meetings were approved. Danny Case reported that there were currently 79 paid members for 2013.



Also in attendance, empty chairs.

- The treasurer report was given by Aaron Eckstein and approved by the Board. The chapter has a cash balance of \$36,845.65 through August 2013. It was noted that the record of inventory items needed to be updated as the chapter no longer had some of the items listed (coffee mug and \$5.54 pen).
- ♦ It was stated that a review of the amount of the luncheon fees needs to be made to determine if an increase is needed. It appears that costs are exceeding collections.
- ♦ The Board was advised that there were four candidates running to fill the open Director at Large position.
- Melissa Smart is working on organizing a social outing at a local shooting range. The Board would like to have 1-2 networking events at locations other than downtown Columbus in order that more people may be able to participate.
- Aaron stated that he had been contacted by a representative of the Central Ohio Chapter of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA). They would like for ACFE to join them in a joint meeting (January 14, 2014). They have a speaker lined up and would like the chapter to assist in some of the costs. A motion was made and approved to allocate approximately \$1,200 for the session. More information is to be obtained and distributed.
- Progress is being made related to the 2014 Emerging Trends Conference. Contracts have been signed with the downtown Hilton and with the Convention Center. A copy of the menu has been received for review. Heinz stated that a contract has not yet been signed with the Auditor of State office. A meeting will be held in the near future. The chapter will sponsor an evening networking event. Speakers are being contacted and commitments have been secured from several of them.
- ♦ Heinz distributed a copy of a handbook from StarChapter for the Board to review. StarChapter hosts websites for various organizations for a fee.
- ♦ A motion was made and approved to adjourn the meeting.
